


The employers point of view

DO NOT


totally match their positions' and the company's needs

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


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

GLOBAL TALENT COMPETITIVENESS INDEX (GTCI) 2018


An international ranking of 119 countries based on their ability to grow, attract and retain talent. The theme of GTCI 2018 is 'Diversity for Competitiveness'.
