



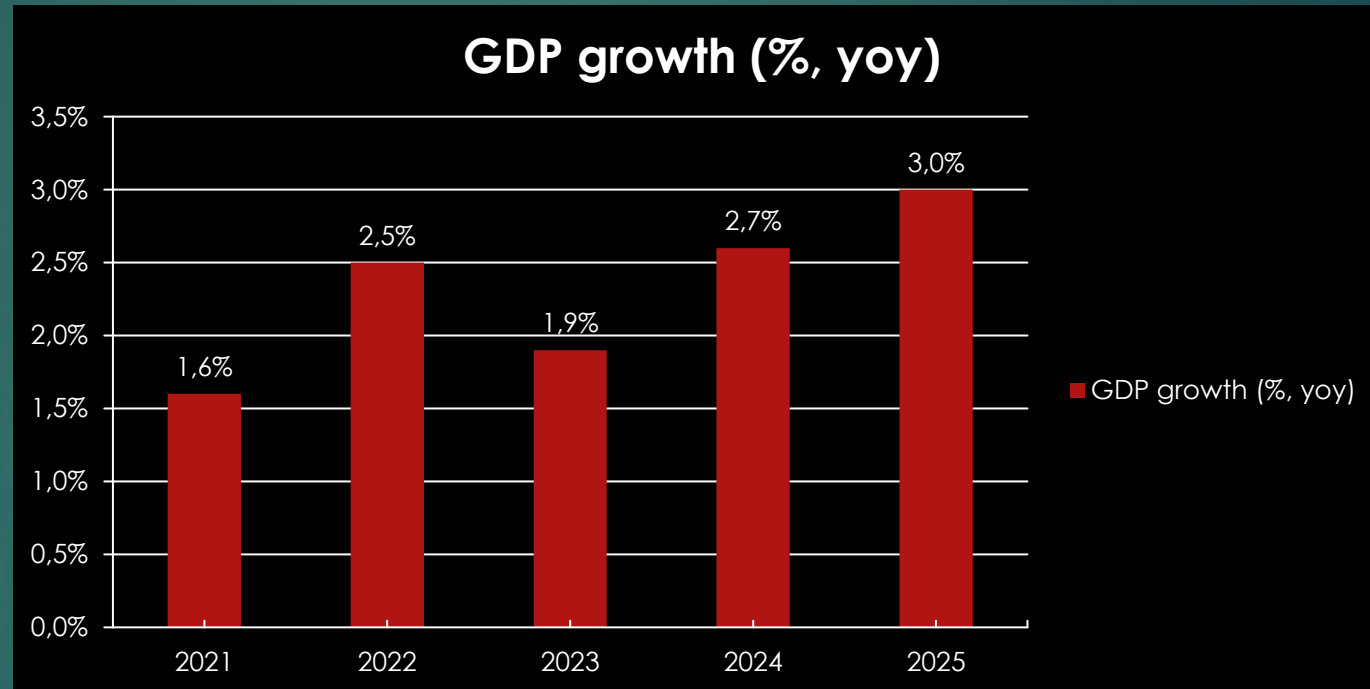

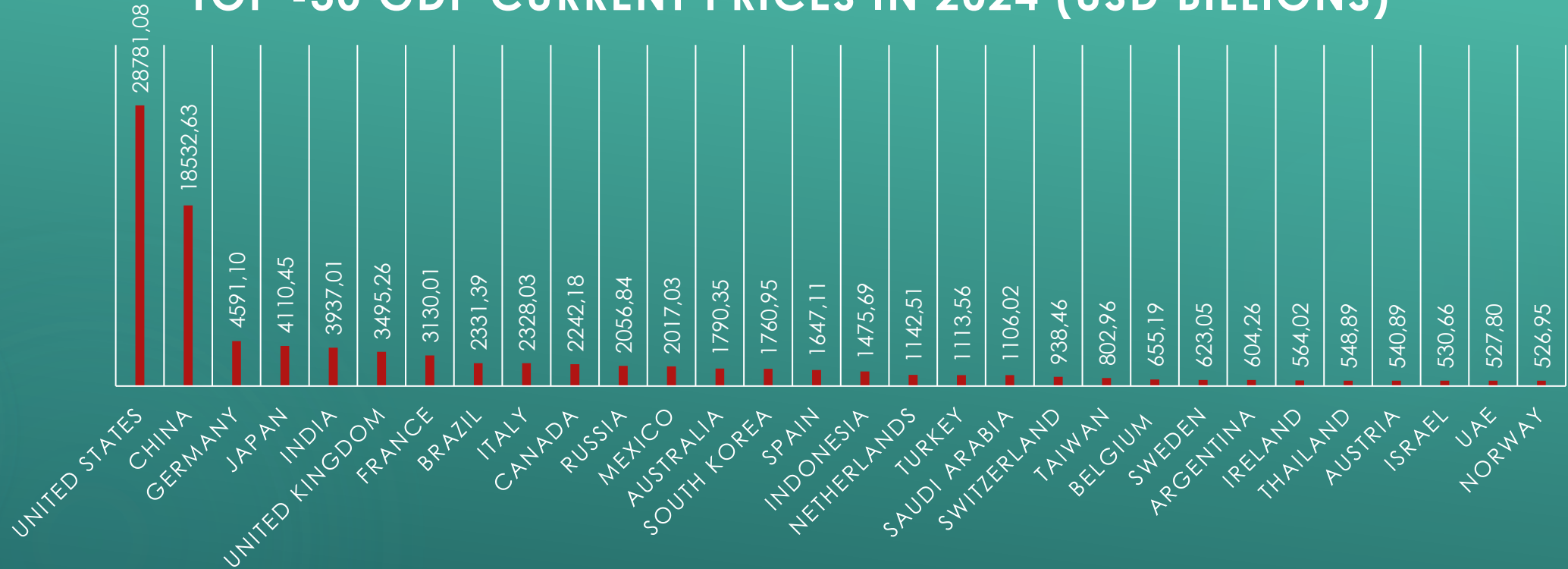

Primary source of food and agricultural commodities, including rice and natural rubber.

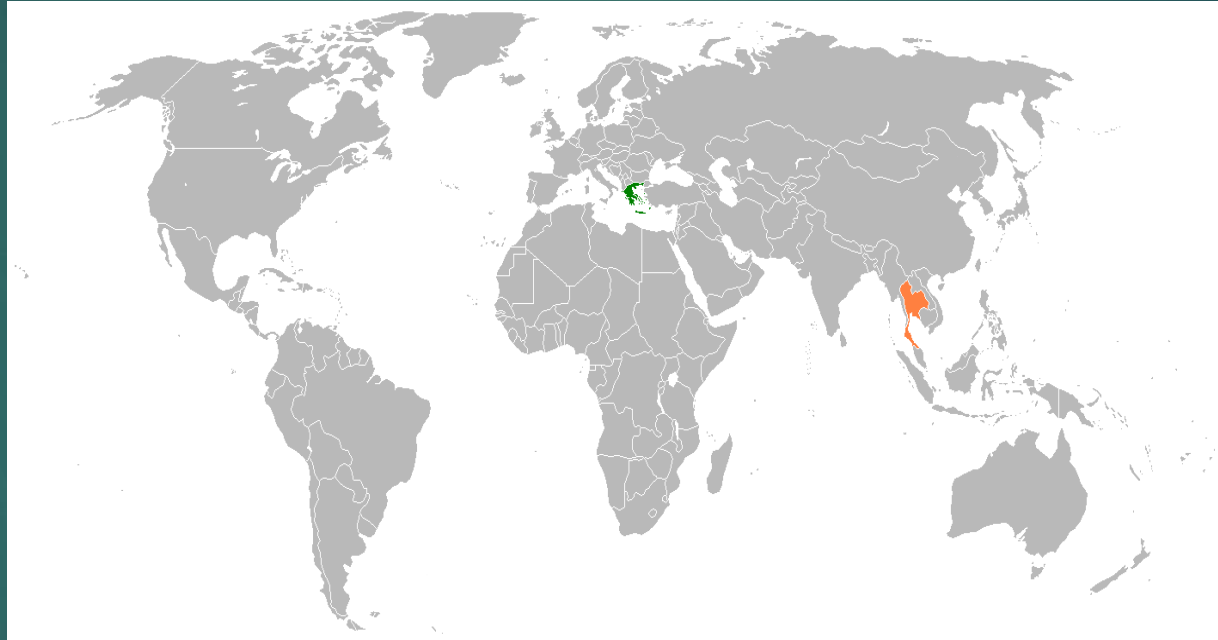

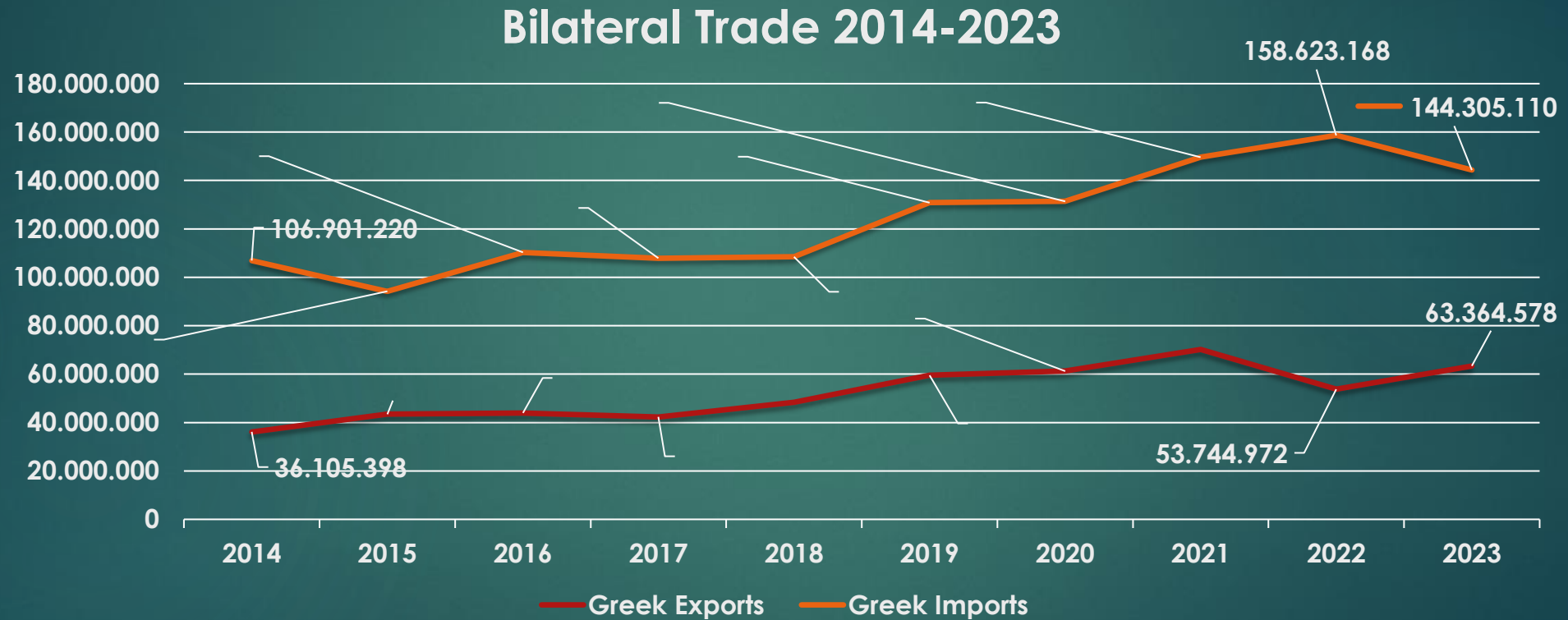

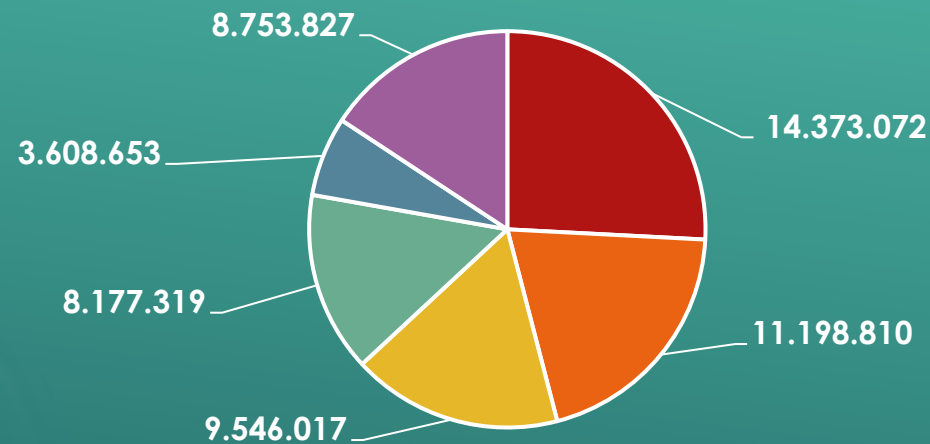

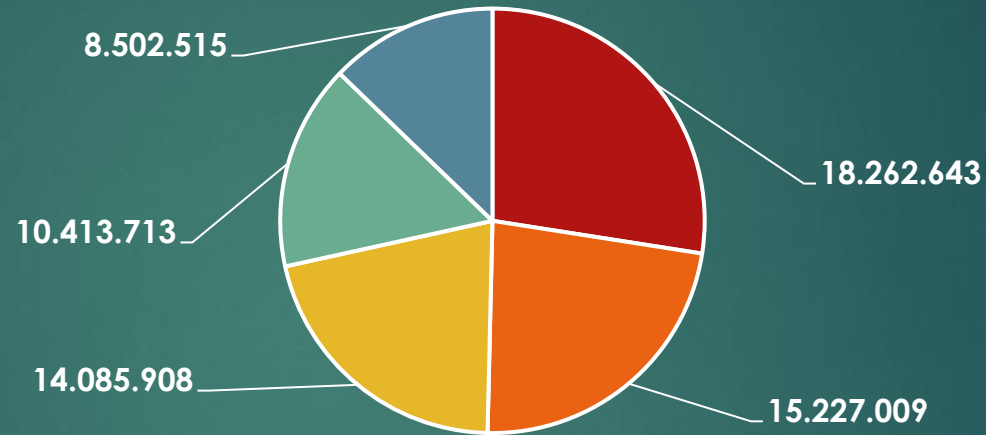
