




Excellent digital connectivity, a highly skilled labor force




Primary source of food and agricultural commodities, including rice and natural rubber.

Greek Exports: 63,4 million Euros Growth: +17,9%



Greek Imports: 144,3 million Euros Decline: -9,63%




Top 5 Greek Exports to Thailand
